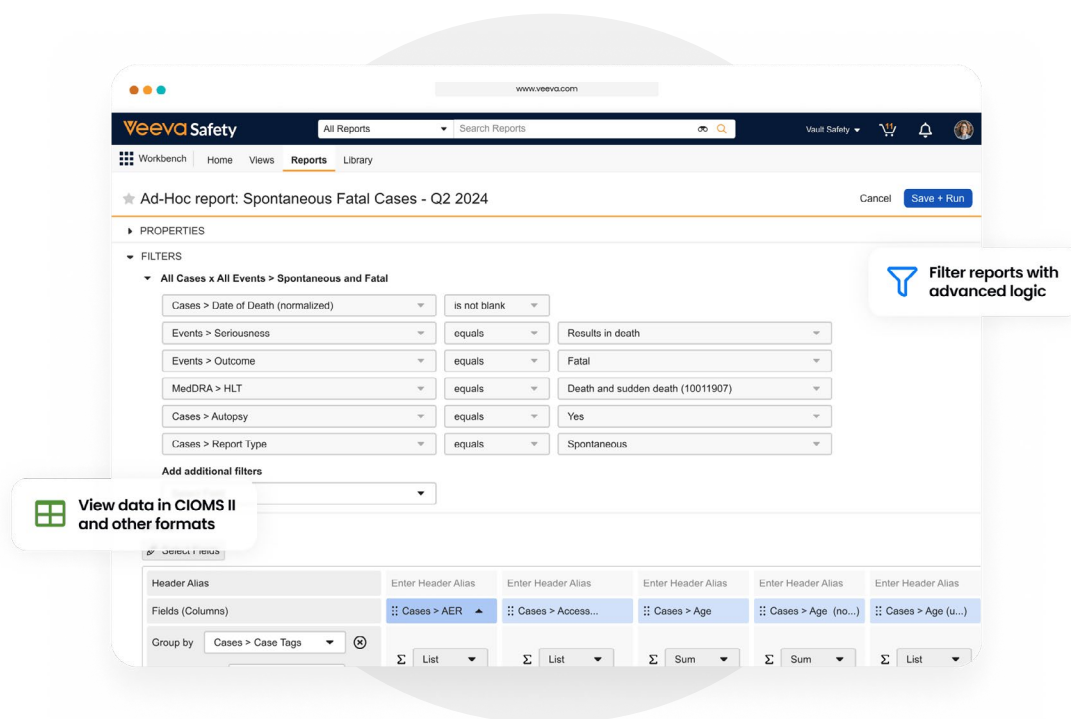

Features

Daily Data Refresh

All Veeva Safety data, including all case versions, is automatically imported nightly into Veeva Safety Workbench and shares a common data model.

Ad hoc Report Builder

Configure new reports and organize the data output using flexible formatting and layouts.

Validated Aggregate Reports

Use prebuilt and validated standard aggregate reports for PADER (with combination products), DSUR, SAR/SUSAR, PBRER, PSUR, CIOMS II, and Japan JPSUR and JDSUR.

Report Sets

Group reports with common filters to execute together in a batch and download the report set as a ZIP file.

Excel Templates

Upload Excel templates to use the predefined report output format.

Report Scheduler

Automatically run and distribute reports based on a predefined schedule.

Report Workflow and Library

Route report outputs for review and approval, generate PDF renditions, and save them to the library.

Case Series
