



VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

To: The Stakeholders of Veeva Systems Inc.

Apex Companies, LLC (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reported by Veeva Systems Inc. (Veeva) for the period stated below. This verification opinion declaration applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions is the sole responsibility of Veeva. Veeva is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions statement in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions reported and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG emissions statement based on the verification. Verification activities applied in a limited level of assurance verification are less extensive in nature, timing and extent than in a reasonable level of assurance verification.

Boundaries of the reporting company GHG emissions covered by the verification:

- Operational Control
- Worldwide

Types of GHGs: CO₂, CH₄, N₂O, HFCs, Other GHGs (HFCs, PFCs, SF₆, NF₃) were present in Scope 3 emission factors

GHG Emissions Statement:

- **Scope 1:** 230 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Location-Based):** 242 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- **Scope 2 (Market-Based):** 60 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent

 - Purchased Goods & Services¹: 34,917 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Capital Goods: 4,377 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Fuel- and Energy-Related Activities: 128 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Upstream Transportation and Distribution: 343 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Waste Generated in Operations: 47 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Business Travel²: 15,198 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent

Data and information supporting the Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions statement were historical in nature but were in some cases estimated. Data and information supporting the Scope 3 GHG emissions statement were in most cases estimated rather than historical in nature.

³ Includes emissions from Work from Home; Employee Commuting and Work From Home emissions include well-to-tank.

- February 1, 2025 to January 31, 2026

Criteria against which verification was conducted:

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2)
- WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3)

Reference Standard:

- ISO 14064-3 Second Edition 2019-04: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements

Level of Assurance and Qualifications:

- Limited
- This verification used a materiality threshold of $\pm 5\%$ for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.

GHG Emissions Verification Methodology:

Evidence-gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Veeva and their consultant;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by Veeva and their consultant;
- Review of Veeva data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis and review of information used to determine GHG emissions; and
- Audit of sample of data used by Veeva to determine GHG emissions.

Verification Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions statement shown above:

- is not materially correct and is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2), and WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3).

It is our opinion that Veeva has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data for determination of these GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.

Statement of independence, impartiality and competence
